- We are lucky to have a wealth of outdoor space, including a woodland area, a running track, a multi surface playground and musical instruments.



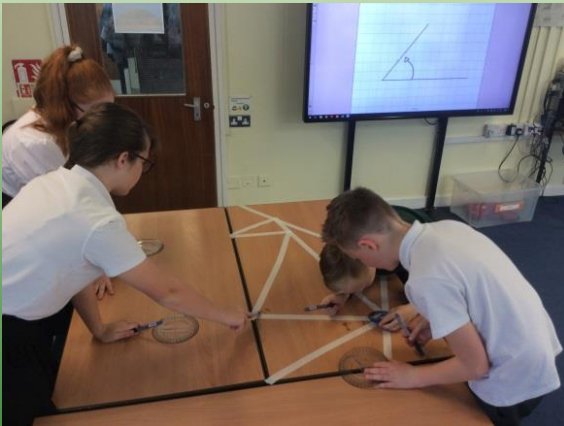
Outside Space continued...

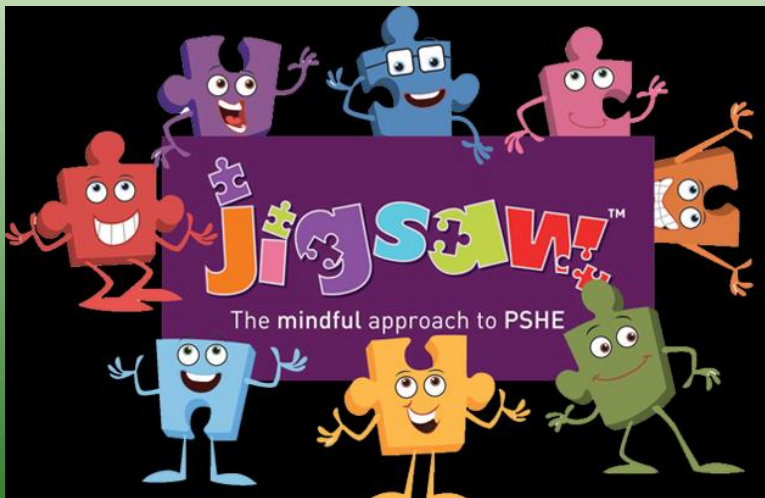
