

# YEAR 6 WORK

If your child is off school due to needing to self-isolate or whilst waiting for results from a Covid-19 test we have sourced the following work for children to complete whilst at home.

## ENGLISH - READING

Read a section or a chapter of your book and choose a VIPERS activity to complete from below.

Vocabulary - note down any unfamiliar words from the chapter and explore the meanings of these words by using a dictionary.

Infer - what might your character be thinking and feeling after recent events? Remember to use evidence from the text.

Predict - what do you think will happen in the next chapter? Remember to think about what has already happened.

Explain - which section/chapter has been most exciting/interesting so far? Remember to back up your explanation with evidence from the text.

Retrieve - Write down five things you have learnt from your book.

Summarise - Draw a cartoon strip to summarise this chapter or the story so far.

## ENGLISH - WRITING

Re-watch [The Umbrella](#) and write the story of the cat going on the adventure after the dog has come home. Where will the cat go...?

## MATHS

Visit Times Tables Rock Stars every day for at least thirty minutes or until you've moved up to the next level.

Each day create a worksheet for one of the four operations (+ - x ÷) that explains what it means and includes at least twenty questions. You will also need to create an answer sheet! Do a different operation each day.
